



## NOTICE INVITING EXPRESSION OF INTERESTS

W.B.Backward Classes Development & Finance Corporation has decided to explore complete software solution integrating its present Web-based MIS incorporating and integrating the following features:

1. Receipt of advances from the apex Corporation (NBCFDC) under various schemes for disbursement of loans sharing 90-95% project cost.
2. Receipt of Share Capital Grant from the State Govt utilised for providing state share of loans disbursed @ 5-10% of Project cost, as well as for meeting other costs.
3. Receipt of fund as recovery of loans regularly segregating the components of principal and interest at different rates for different schemes and booking thereof against individual ledgers and thereby generating subsequent demands and calculating overdue amount.
4. Repayment of advances to NBCFDC on quarterly basis against demands and maintaining records of difference of payment component-wise that might increase the overdue amount.
5. Inclusion of other receipts and payments towards staff salary, office expenses etc.
6. Generating various proforma reports including Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account with the data in store under different heads as indicated above.
7. Generating Loan sanction order and repayment schedule for individual beneficiaries area-wise and scheme-wise.
8. Tracking the defaulters and alerting them by using mobile phone numbers and other particulars in store.
9. Analysing and clustering the performance and impact in the context of disbursement of loan.
10. Generating other reports and replies as normally required for statutory audit of accounts by the CAG.

The aforesaid features to be taken care of are indicative and they may be modified or expanded as per requirement within a reasonable period which needs to be supported and accommodated free of cost.

The package should be designed in such a way that it is user friendly, it does not require computer professionals to operate and entire entries as may be required on daily basis can be handled by two persons centrally. There should not be any multiple entries at any point for one single field. In other words, any data entered once can be used for different purposes at different stages.

In order to develop and operate an integrated, multipurpose and simplified software package the Corporation looks forward to receive Expression of Interest from qualified engineers, firms having reputation of developing similar computer solutions for Government/public institutions.

Technical Bids and other documents from the intending individuals/organisations will be received along with the Financial Bids in separate and sealed covers before 2:00 PM on 28-12-2012 by the undersigned. A demo of the proposed work may be presented on 27-12-2012 in the office chamber of the undersigned which may be taken into consideration while examining the Technical Bids.

Financial Bids will include cost of training and maintenance for one year.
